IMPORTANT HOUSING INFORMATION:

Meal Plans:

- Participation in a meal plan is mandatory EXCEPT University Park South & North.
- Block Meal Plans are per semester and will roll over at the beginning of the Spring semester.
- 80 Block and 112 Block are only for non-freshman students in TCS or VCS.

Initial Payment - Cost includes:

- A one-time \$40 Installment Fee
- A \$200 refundable security deposit
- A \$30 optional activities fee (non-refundable after opening day)
- A \$30 nonrefundable application fee

Installment payments:

- All subsequent Installment payments are due by the first of each month starting with Installment #2 due on September 1 and ending with Installment #9 due on April 1.
- A \$20 late fee will be charged for all payments made after 5pm on the fifth of the month.

Room Occupancy: All units are shared.

- Triple Occupancy rooms will have three students sharing one-bedroom.
- Double Occupancy rooms will have two students sharing one bedroom.
- Single Occupancy rooms will have one student in their own bedroom.

Financial Aid Recipients:

- As per Title V of the California Administrative Code, § 668.165 an institution may use Title IV, HEA program funds to credit a student's account at the institution to satisfy current charges for (ii) Board, if the student contracts with the institution for board; and (iii) Room, if the student contracts with the institution for the room.
- Students who receive financial aid are not eligible for the Installment Payment Plan.
