FALL 2021 MOVE-IN | PACKING LIST

Wondering what to bring on Move-in Day? Below is a list of recommended and prohibited items along with some packing tips to help you get started with packing.

PACKING TIPS

1 | PACK LIGHTLY

Bring only what you absolutely need. Given the current health crisis, residents will need to be prepared for potential housing changes and should minimize the amount of personal belongings they bring to campus.

2 | MAKE IT EASIER

Leave your clothes on the hangers and place them in a large trash bag with a hole cut in the top. They'll be easy to place in your vehicle and easy to hang up when you arrive.

3 | BE SUSTAINABLE

Pack in reusable storage containers to reduce waste.

Only ONE vehicle will be allowed at each unloading area, so try to consolidate items as much as possible. Keep in mind that if you are having a hard time making everything fit, then you're bringing too much.

4 | TALK IT OVER

To avoid bringing duplicate items, check in with your apartment-mate(s) to coordinate items that will be shared in your room or apartment.

ADDITIONAL ITEMS (UNFURNISHED UNITS)

- Bed & mattress
- Coffee table
- Dining table & chairs
- Desk & chair
- Living room seating
- Microwave
- TV stand
- Wardrobe/closet

LEAVE IT | The list below is not all-inclusive. Any item that is a threat to public safety will be confiscated.

- » Alcohol or other drug paraphernalia
- » Candles, incense, or anything with an open flame
- » Large furniture that will not fit in your room. Furniture already in your room cannot be moved or removed.
- » Pets not previously approved
- » Space heaters
- » Toaster ovens and hot plates
- » Weapons
